Certificate in TCM Assistant Course is specially designed for clinical assistants, TCM related personnel and the general public for an overview of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). It includes the basic knowledge and diagnostics of TCM, TCM Wellness and Rehabilitation, Nutrition and Dietetics, and skill and technique of massage. It is a 2-year part-time course, comprising 9 subjects, totaling 604 course hours. Apart from enhancing knowledge in TCM for personal healthcare and wellness, completion of the course could lead to TCM Career opportunities such as clinical assistants to registered TCM practitioners, assistants in nursing homes, etc.

Course Objectives:

1. To train clinical assistants for better understanding in TCM.
2. To acquire skills and techniques of massage.
3. To learn TCM Nutrition and Dietetics for self-awareness and knowledge in Traditional Chinese Medicine to initiate healthy lifestyles.
4. To manage the TCM clinics effectively for better service to the general public.

1. Assistant to TCM Physicians and carry out operations of TCM Clinics.
2. TCM Dispenser to provide more professional service.
3. Professional Masseur to assist TCM Physicians for medical treatment and wellness.
